As an academic publisher in the life sciences, CABI helps people discover validated, evidence-based information to help them overcome the world's biggest challenges.

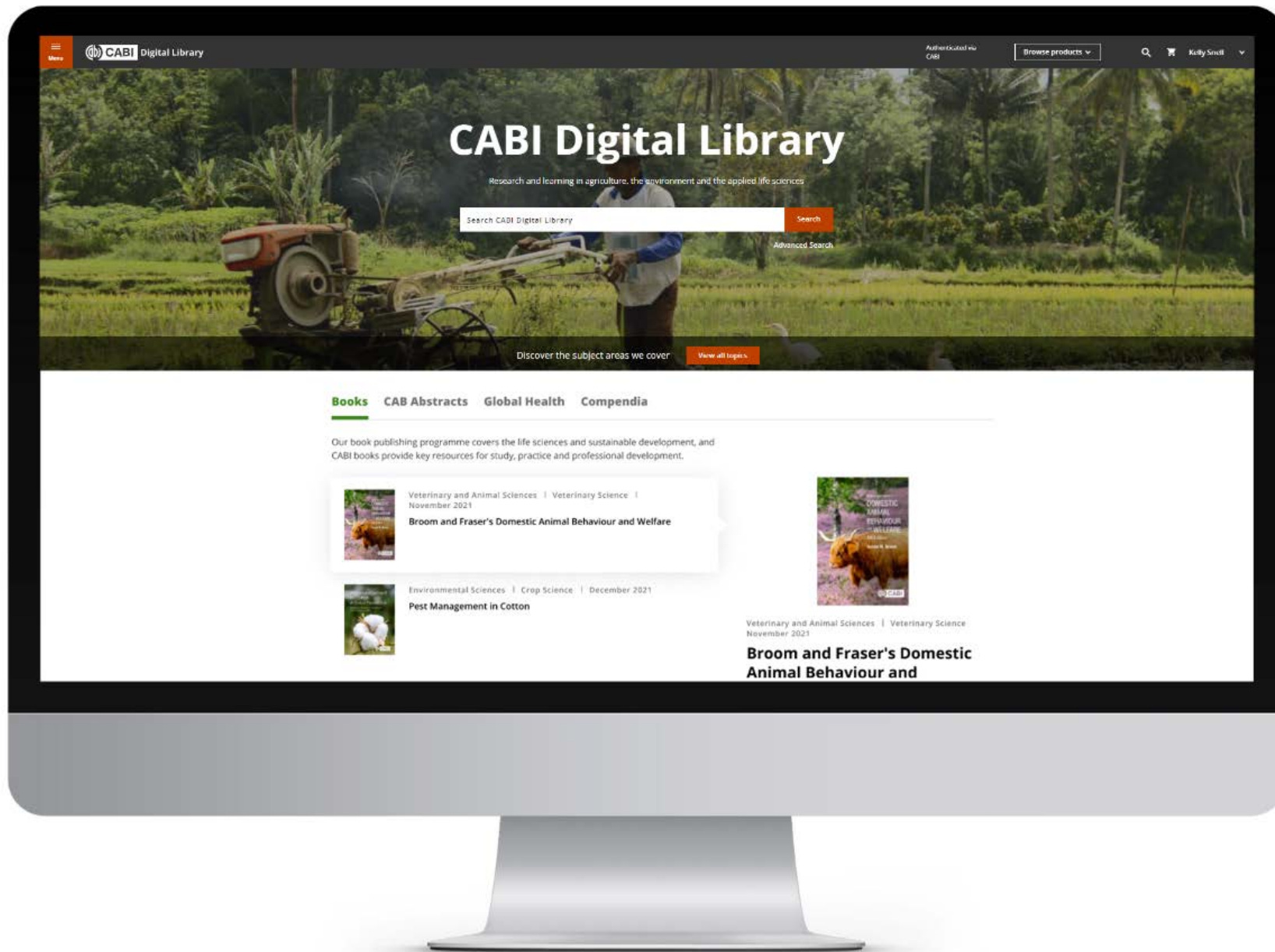

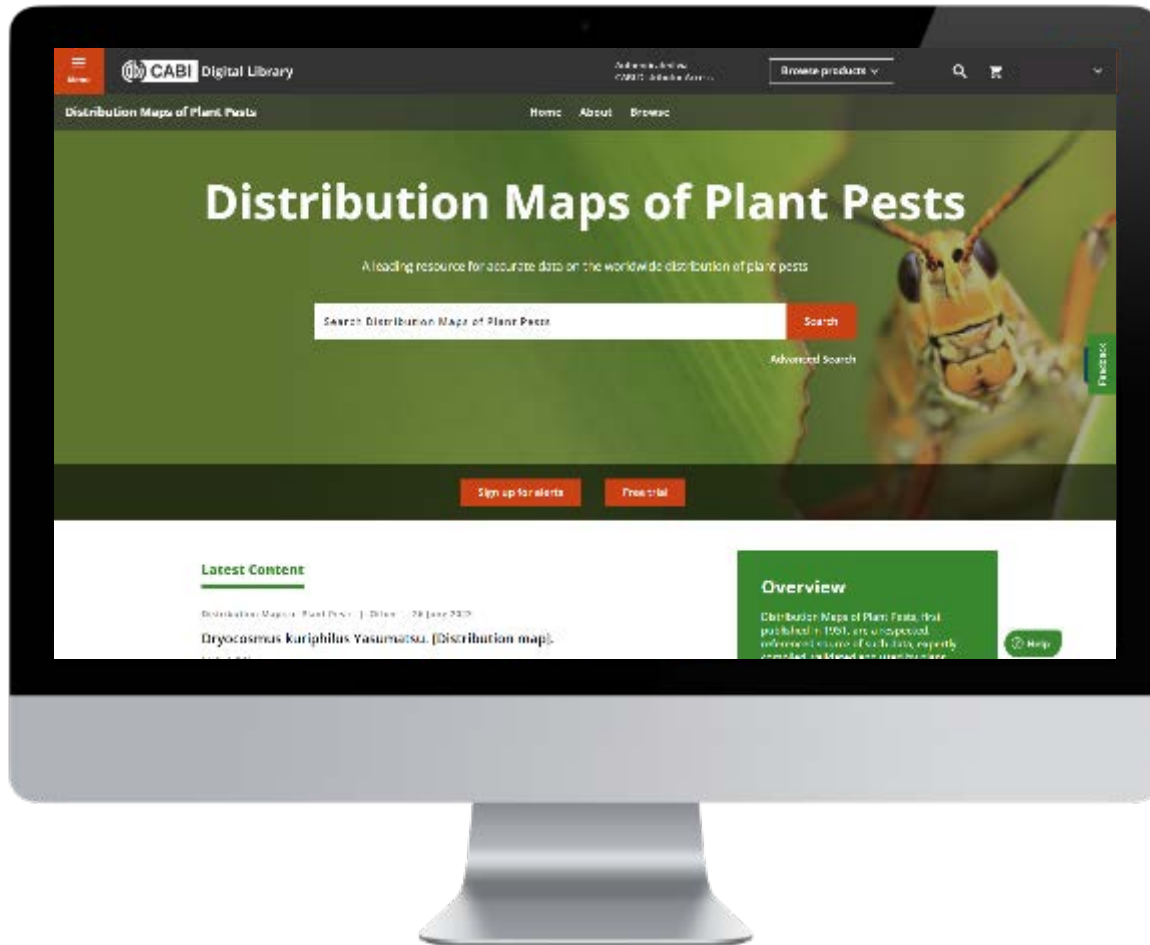
Distribution Maps of Plant Diseases
