Collected Papers Database

The database provides two search methods: general search and advanced search.

1. General Search

(1) Select the search resource type and scope. The default search conditions for general searches are: Search all + Search full text



(2) Enter keywords and click Search.



(3) View the search results and conduct a secondary search based on your needs. Support: ① Filter results by resource type; ② Provide sorting by relevance, publication time, and update time; ③ Provide browsing by subject, region, year, author, and industry.



2. Advanced Search

(1) Click the Advanced Search button to enter the Advanced Search.



(2) Supports multi-condition combination search. Including: ① Freely select the search resource type; ② Freely add or remove condition items; ③ Freely define the content of condition items, including full text, title, author, abstract, and keywords; ④ Freely define the logical relationship of the combination of conditions, including AND, OR, and NOT; ⑤ Freely select the time range for search.



The database provides two online reading modes: **HTML online reading** and **PDF original reading**.

1. Click any report title to enter the report information page.



2. If you are an individual user and your institution has not purchased the database, when you click on online reading or original reading, a payment page will pop up. After completing the payment, you can enter the HTML online reading or PDF original reading page. If you are a formal institutional user, you can directly enter the reading page.

3. Click on **online reading** to enter the HTML online reading page. This reading method has the following advantages: 1 The content is presented in web text mode; 2 It can be used in an online state;



4. Click on **the original version** to enter the PDF original version reading page. This reading method has the following advantages: ① The content will be presented in the form of the original paper book; ② No plug-in installation is required; ③ Online printing, zooming, and page skipping are supported.



Download and read

1. Click **Download to read**. The browser will automatically download the PDF file. It needs to be used with a local PDF reader.
